Audiology -- This department works with people of all ages to determine the type and extent of hearing loss and the appropriate treatment. Comprehensive services include: hearing evaluations, hearing aids and assistive listening devices, such as TTYs, amplified telephones and visual fire alarms. This department additionally holds special community days throughout the year to offer free hearing screenings or free hearing aid maintenance.

Comprehensive Program for the Deaf (CPD) -- This program is a vocational training and placement program for adults who are Deaf or Hard-of-Hearing. The goal for all students of this program is independent living and a full-time job. Components of the program include: assessment of student abilities and interests; development of independent living skills; community-based work experiences; preparation for the job search process and; job placement.

Speech Pathology -- Through speech and language testing and treatment, this department works to establish and restore communication skills. The department offers a variety of treatment programs to both children and adults.
