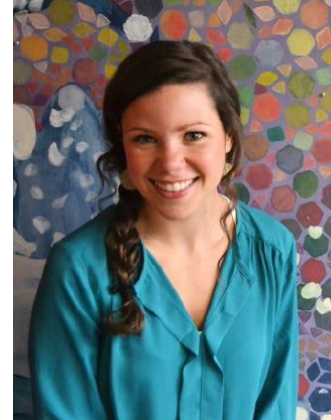
Welcome Kelly!
