Weather Policy

INCLEMENT WEATHER

Columbus Speech & Hearing Center will remain open for business except in the most severe weather conditions. Generally, the Center will be closed only if the City of Columbus declares a Level 2 or Level 3 Emergency or in the event of a power outage.

The decision to close the Center will be made on a case-by-case basis.

If you are uncertain whether or not we will be open during, or following, a severe weather event, please check to see if we are included in the list of community closings broadcast on local media.

You can also call the Center at 614-263-5151. The Center's voicemail greeting will be recorded, as early as possible, indicating whether or not we will be open. (In the event of a power failure we would not be able to record a message and you would need to rely on local media for information.)

If we should need to close the Center early, we will attempt to contact any clients who are scheduled. Please be sure the Business Office has ALL of your most current contact numbers.
