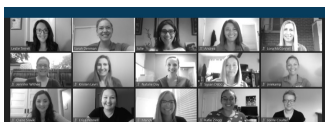
That's why we are thrilled to share a brand-new look with you!

Our team has been working diligently over the past several months to launch a more modernized brand, including a new logo, updated name and website that better reflects the evolution of our organization and where we're headed.

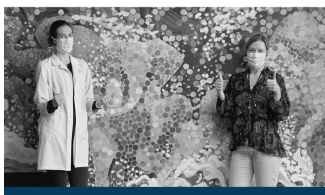
Our new website features the following:
