

Walter & Marian English Awards are given to individuals who demonstrate a strong commitment to the field of human services through the provision of direct services to individuals and/or families. The Award is a grant that is designated for the recipient to use for professional development.

<u>Julie</u> will be focusing on professional development and participating in continuing education opportunities that expand her knowledge and treatment of young children (birth - 3yrs) and preschoolers with speech and language disorders.

Many of the clients Julie sees at Columbus Speech & Hearing, as well as those at her contracted preschool, are 1 - 5 years of age. This type of speech therapy is family-centered and includes a combination of parent coaching and counseling. In the school setting, it also includes play-based approaches provided in the classroom. The continuing education courses Julie will be taking will focus on how children with communication disorders learn at a young age, and how she can support their ability to effectively communicate with others. Some of these trainings and conferences include: The American Speech-Hearing Association Convention, The PLAY Project and Learn Play Thrive Approach to Autism.
