HEARING & DEAFBLIND STATISTICS IN CENTRAL OHIO

Nearly 17% of people in central Ohio will experience hearing loss in their lifetime. This equates to 425,000 individuals in central Ohio.

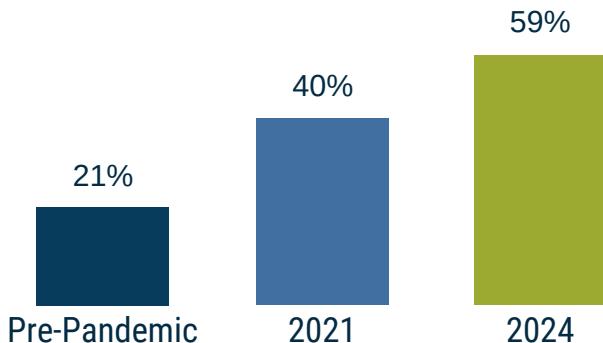


On average, people who have symptoms of hearing loss will wait **7 years** before seeking help.

In Ohio, there are about **84,797 DeafBlind individuals**. Columbus Speech & Hearing currently serves 33+ adults with deafblindness, and we continue to receive applications from all over Ohio.

The Need Continues to Grow

CSH conducts hearing screenings in vulnerable Columbus neighborhoods each year. Since the pandemic, the screening failure rate has dramatically increased.

JANA | DEAFBLIND SUPPORT

Fairy tales often end with “happily ever after.” Sometimes the main character has challenges before that happy ending. Jana is a 19-year-old woman who is DeafBlind. Throughout high school, she faced profound isolation. Making friends was difficult. Her family did not know sign language, and efforts to seek mental health support left her without help.

Everything changed when Jana began researching guide dogs. Leader Dogs for the Blind introduced her to Mika, the guide dog. Their bond was immediate.

Today, Jana is studying in college to be a mental health professional for individuals who are DeafBlind. Mika is by her side. Jana also has Support Service Provider assistance at Columbus Speech & Hearing as she builds an independent life.

TERRY | AUDIOLOGY

As a licensed psychotherapist, Terry Taylor knows how critical it is for people to feel truly heard. But when his own hearing started to decline due to high-frequency hearing loss in his mid-20s, it became harder for him to stay connected. Terry began to notice his symptoms affecting his relationships, career, and mental health. Noisy gatherings left him lost in conversation.

Terry turned to Columbus Speech & Hearing. His Audiologist not only fitted him with new hearing aids, but also helped him secure funding through Opportunities for Ohioans with Disabilities. “Without that support, I wouldn’t have been able to afford my hearing aids. And I wouldn’t be where I am now.”

Now, Terry leads major meetings at one of Franklin County’s largest mental health centers and continues to support others. Outside of work, he enjoys a vibrant social life and playing with his dog Max.
